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Potential 2006 H2A Jobs in Michigan

Updated 3/29/2006 Several agricultural employers have submitted job orders that could result in them being granted permission to bring foreign "guestworkers" into the U.S. under the federal H2A program. To be approved for H2A guestworkers, the employers have to assert that there is a shortage of workers in the area where the work will take place, due to them not being able to fill the jobs through advertisements and normal recruiting methods.

U.S. citizens and immigrants living in the U.S. have the right to apply for these jobs. If the employer finds enough qualified U.S. citizens or residents for the job, then they will not have to bring guestworkers into the U.S. H2A jobs have to pay at least **\$9.43 per hour** in Michigan (starting 3/16/2006), and the employer has to provide housing to any worker who is not from the local area. From March 2, 2005 to March 15, 2006, the required H2A wage rate was \$9.18 per hour. All the jobs listed below offer 40 hours per week.

Some job orders shown below may have been submitted before the wage rate increased from \$9.18 to \$9.43, however all H2A jobs must pay \$9.43 starting March 16, 2006.

Migrant and seasonal farmworkers who are already in the United States have a right to apply for these jobs and to receive the same terms and conditions that foreign guestworkers should receive. **They can apply up until the half-way point (shown below) of the employment period**. They should receive the same benefits of employment that the employer would give to a foreign worker.

This means that U.S. workers can receive the following benefits:

- an hourly wage of at least \$9.43 per hour
- free and licensed housing if the worker does not live within commuting distance
- a guarantee to be paid for at least 75% of the period of employment shown below
- the cost of travel from the place of recruitment to the job site, after completing 50% of the contract period
- the cost of travel back home, after completing the contract period
- workers compensation insurance
- a record of the amount of work performed and amount paid, including deductions

Farmworker Legal Services will counsel H2A workers about their rights under their contracts, as well as advise U.S. workers who are not given a chance to obtain the H2A jobs that the law permits them to obtain.
