## Potential 2013 H2A Jobs in Michigan

Updated 8/21/2013

Several agricultural employers have submitted job orders that may result in them being granted permission to bring foreign “guestworkers” into the U.S. under the federal H2A program. To be approved to use H2A guestworkers, the employers have to show that they have been unsuccessful in locating sufficient numbers of qualified U.S. applicants for the jobs. They must keep the “H2A jobs” open to all qualified U.S. workers through the end of the designated recruitment period.

U.S. citizens and immigrants with work authorization have the right to apply for these jobs. If the employer finds enough qualified U.S. citizens or residents for the jobs, then they will not need to bring guestworkers into the U.S. The employer must provide free housing to any worker who is not from the local area. All jobs listed below offer 40 hours per week, unless otherwise noted.

All eligible workers, including migrant and seasonal farmworkers who apply for these jobs, have the legal right to the same terms and conditions that foreign guestworkers are promised. The employer must provide employment to any able, willing, qualified, and available U.S. worker who applies to the employer until 50% of the contract period has elapsed. Individuals interested in the job can also contact the Michigan Workforce Development Agency (also known as the job service).

Domestic workers in the U.S. and H2A guestworkers should both receive the following benefits:

- Hourly wage as noted below in each job order
- Free and licensed housing if the worker does not live within commuting distance
- A guarantee that the employer will comply with all H2A program requirements
- Workers compensation insurance
- The cost of travel from the place of recruitment to the job site, after completing 50% of the contract period
- The cost of travel back home, after completing the contract period
- A record of the amount of work performed and amount paid, including deductions

Farmworker Legal Services will counsel H2A visa holders about their rights under their contracts, U.S. workers who obtain these “H2A” jobs, and potential U.S. workers who are denied their right to obtain these jobs.
